
Understanding families...


Parents build the future with the way they raise their kids. Spiritual formation begins in the family and the home is the critical shaping ground for faith. OneHope wanted to better understand how parents perceive their influence and the realities of their parent/child relationships. This research study focused on families in five countries.



The research explores parenting styles and goals, challenges, and family conversational rhythms. Parents were instructed to answer the survey questions with their oldest child in mind. OneHope's Research Team collected data from 2,051 parents between February 25 - March 2, 2022.


